

## **FIRE PROTECTION REGULATIONS**

1. Compliance with the current fire protection regulations and the current Fire Protection Regulations issued by DUE for dormitory residents and everyone who uses the dormitory's services - are mandatory.
2. Any activity that may cause a fire or explosion or endanger the physical safety of others in the entire area of the dormitory - is prohibited.
3. The use of electric cooking appliances, gas hobs, grills, toasters, immersion heaters, etc. is prohibited in the rooms. Only devices that are in perfect technical condition and comply with the Hungarian Standard are permitted.
4. The socket of electrical appliances may only be used in accordance with the regulations.
5. The use of open flames in the rooms is prohibited. Smoking is only permitted in the designated area.
6. The use of electric heaters in the rooms is prohibited.
7. Lighting devices must be placed and used in such a way that they cannot cause a fire. Flammable decorative materials must not be placed on lighting equipment.
8. Traffic and escape routes must not be blocked or narrowed, even temporarily.
9. Apart from the furnishings and personal items and materials necessary for living and normal living, it is forbidden to place or accumulate any inappropriate objects or materials! It is necessary to avoid increasing the fire load of the residential units and endangering rapid evacuation in the event of a fire.
10. In the event of a fire, the receptionist must be notified. The dormitory members must be alerted, and the building must be evacuated in an orderly manner. The building can be left outdoors through the corridors and stairwells, or the emergency exits must be used.
11. In the event of a fire, place a moistened textile in front of your face to avoid possible smoke poisoning. Visibility is generally good near the ground, in order to find your way around, escape is attempted in this position if necessary.
12. In the event of non-compliance with the Fire Safety Policy, the operator may initiate disciplinary action, compensation, or a fire department fine.
13. When detecting a small fire, it is the duty of every resident to extinguish the fire using the fire extinguishers and wall hydrants that are on standby in the corridors.
14. Electrical appliances may only be extinguished with water after the power has been disconnected.
15. The dormitory building is equipped with a fire alarm system, intelligent fire alarm systems and manual fire detectors. When these are activated, the siren sounds, the fire doors close automatically (they can be opened manually), the reception is alerted, and the fire department is notified with a delay.
16. In the event of a fire, the residents of the dormitory must leave the building via the stairwells (the elevator will then automatically go down to the ground floor and the doors will open).
17. In the event of a fire alarm caused by negligence – false or real – the service fee invoiced by the Disaster Management Authority and the extraordinary inspection fee of the equipment maintenance company must be paid via the Neptun Unified Study System.
